

EPTA 2019 Conference: 1st to 4th July



International Apostolic Bible College, Kolding, Denmark. Pentecostalism in a Changing World

This three-day conference promises to be personally refreshing and deeply rewarding, both academically and in terms of networking. Academic papers and discussion will be interspersed with times of fellowship and prayer for those who wish. As ever, there will be a free afternoon for outings. Residential and day visitors are welcome.

DATES

The conference will run from the evening of Monday July 1st, starting with a meal at 18:00, to the morning of Thursday July 4th, 2019, finishing after breakfast.

THEME

The theme of the conference will be 'Pentecostalism in a Changing World'. Academic papers will be presented and discussions will be held on various aspects of this topic and its ramifications in Pentecostal life and mission in Europe today.

EPTA is delighted to announce that world-renowned theologian Professor Veli-Matti Kärkkäinen (Fuller Theological Seminary; University of Helsinki) will be speaking at two plenary sessions. There will also be an informal evening of questions and answers with him.



WELCOME

All members of EPTA are encouraged to attend. As ever, others interested in the work of EPTA are warmly welcome, especially research students. Those living close to Kolding are welcome

as day visitors. Pastors and others involved in church life on a day-to-day basis will find much of interest in the conference. There are day rates for local visitors (see below).

Conference places are only available for EU passport holders or those who have a visa to enter the EU. Apologies to all others as EPTA cannot facilitate visa entries.

VENUE

The 2019 venue is the [International Apostolic Bible College, Lykkegårdsvej 100, DK-6000 Kolding, Denmark](#). The college offers lovely facilities and excellent food.

Some accommodation is available at IABC (40 persons in shared rooms—two single beds per room—and 5 persons in single rooms). Sheets and towels will be provided to all accommodated on campus. There are no en-suite washing and toilet facilities. Instead, each storey in the accommodation block has bathrooms. There is a lift/elevator to all bedrooms. Accommodation is offered on a first-come, first-served basis. No IABC accommodation is available for fewer than the full three nights.

Meals provided by IABC can include vegetarian, gluten-free, and lactose-free. Please indicate any special requirements at online registration.

HOTELS

If, when you register, IABC accommodation is full, you will be informed of this, and will need to reserve accommodation at a local hotel. Three are recommended. If you want to stay in one of these, please make a direct reservation with the hotel. Those staying in a hotel will need to make their own transport arrangements to the conference venue.

COSTS

Total fees: Please pay once you receive your personalised invoice which will be sent to you after your online registration. All registration payments must be in Euros. Note, however, that Danish currency is Krone, not Euros, in case you wish to bring cash for small expenses.

Registration + IABC accommodation, per person

Registration fee (whole conference) + accommodation fee = 25 € + 175 € = **200 €**.

Registration + meals, per person

Whole Conference:

Registration fee (whole conference) + meals fee = 25 € + 70 € = **95 €**.

Per day:

Registration fee (per day) + meals fee (per day) = 9 € + 30 € = **39 € per day**.

These are made up of the elements set out below:

Registration fee. All delegates, both residential and day visitors, pay this. It is set by EPTA and covers general EPTA costs such as running the conference. This small charge, unchanged from last year, is non-refundable.

Registration fee (whole conference): **25 €.**

Registration fee (day rate, per day): **9 €.**

IABC Accommodation fee. IABC accommodation is reserved and paid for through EPTA. It is set by IABC, and will be passed on by EPTA to the college. It is more than the 2018 fee, but similar to that charged in 2017. There is no difference in charge per person for accommodation in a single or shared room. Three nights' accommodation, refreshments, meals, and hire of sheets and towels are included. Accommodation charge, per person: **175 €.**

Meal fees: For those attending the whole conference, and staying in hotels or living locally, the total cost for lunches, evening meals and refreshments at IABC is **70 €.**

For visitors attending only one or two days, the cost of lunch, evening meal and refreshments is **30 € per day.**

TRAVEL

For those arriving at Billund Airport, [there is an airport bus going to Kolding town.](#)

The bus from Billund to Kolding is Line 166.

From Kolding station and the town centre to IABC, choose bus number 5 or 4, destination "Lykkegårdsvej" ([see timetable in Danish](#))

Alternatively, there are taxi rides available from Kolding train station. A walk from the town centre to IABC takes about 30 to 35 minutes, leads through the whole town and ends up with a long hill.

REGISTRATION

All those attending the conference must submit an [online registration form](#). A separate form must be filled out for each person attending. An invoice for payment will be sent following online registration. To help planning, please register by May 31st, 2019.

By giving your name and institution on the online registration form, you thereby permit these details to be shared with other conference delegates. Other personal details, such as your email address, will not be shared with them.
